Challenge the other team to a game of Wordle. Go to the Wordle Unlimited site and complete 3 Wordles. Tally the total number of guesses you use. Whichever team has the lowest amount wins. You have five minutes to complete the wordles. If you do not complete the wordles in time, then you forfeit. You may not use any additional tools to help you.

Find the highest house number, and take a photo in front of the house. The street doesn't matter, and doesn't have to be claimed by you. You may not consult any resources except for Google Maps to verify what the number of a house is. You may not use Google Maps to search for houses. You have five minutes, and may only search within a 1/3 of a mile of where you started the challenge.

The attacking team will think of a yes-or-no question for the other team to answer. They will also need to guess what the other team's answer will be. They will then ask the team the question. If they predict their answer correctly, they win the street. Else, the attacked team keeps both streets. The team that is asked the question can answer however they want, even if it is not the truth.

You have 10 minutes to find the most foreign license plates. Foreign license plates count as any license plates that are not from New York. Non-NY US plates count as 1 point. Other country license plates count as 10 points. You may go anywhere on the map to look for license plates. At the end of 10 minutes, the team with the most points win.

Both teams will face off in a Web Math Minute competition. Both teammates will have the option to compete. Set the settings to Multiplication, Min 0, Max 12, 50 questions, and 2 minutes. Once both teammates compete, the fastest time is kept. Whichever team had the faster time wins both roads.

Find the most expensive item in any store. This does not include restaurants and the price must be the labeled price. You do not have to buy the item. If there is no store within a ¼ mile of you or the other team and in the game area, then another challenge must be picked.

Once this challenge is drawn, both teams have 10 minutes to find the most amount of animals. Each animal must be photographed successfully. At the end of the 10 minutes, the team that photographed the most animals will keep both streets.



Whenever this battle is initiated, both teams must attempt to locate the most expensive house on their current street. They may not use any real estate or other house pricing websites, but they may use Google Maps to find and inspect the house. Once both teams are ready, the team that is closest to finding the most expensive house on their street wins. If both teams find the most expensive house, the one whose house is the most expensive wins.

Play a game of photographic tag. The rules are simple, the first team to take a photo of the other team wins. The photo can contain any part of either one or both team members, but it must be clearly a team member. If you are within 1,000 ft of each other or if you are over ½ mile away from each other, pick another battle challenge. Both teams must leave their trackers ON!

The first team to break a law from Crime Spree wins this challenge. Use the list of crimes on the website to find one. It can be any law, but must notably be the law you are trying to break. Don't break any "real" laws while in the process. Once you are finished, send the video to the other team to verify that you correctly broke the law.

The first team to obtain a newspaper or other publication and successfully solve one of the puzzles in it wins this challenge. You can get the publication anywhere, and you can solve any puzzle in it. If the puzzle is incorrectly solved, you must try again on a new puzzle. You may not use anything to help you solve the puzzle except yourselves.

Once you pull this card, the other team has the chance to either claim both roads being battled for and be frozen for 5 minutes, or they can not be frozen, but give both streets to you. Alert the other team as soon as you pull this battle challenge. They have 2 minutes to decide.

Once this card is pulled, both teams must race to find two advertisements. They must be "in the wild", and cannot be from any of a teammate's item. Once one team finds two, they claim both roads. An advertisement can be a poster, on a vehicle, or simply a sign for a business.
